Our Community Update

DEAR FRIENDS OF THE LAGUNA,



When I look at the Laguna watershed in 2019, I can't help but think about the state of the creeks that travel across the Santa Rosa Plain. It is hard to imagine the gravel-lined ditches stripped of their trees and shrubs of 40 years ago. Following drastic changes and channelization, in the 1970s these creeks were declared "devoid of life." For the past 30 years, the Laguna Foundation has been working to bring these creeks back to life. Working with public agencies and private landowners, the Laguna Foundation has been able to positively impact the streams that feed the Laguna channel by improving water quality and building lush riparian vegetation that offer habitat and wildlife corridors.

We recognize the importance of the Laguna Foundation's contribution to mitigating the climate crisis. Reducing carbon emissions is not enough. At this critical juncture we all must do more in mitigating climate change. The more than 70,000 trees and shrubs planted by the Laguna Foundation are drawing carbon from the atmosphere. By the same token, our grasslands management and invasive plant control programs are sequestering carbon and increasing biodiversity.

In this annual report, we share many of the accomplishments and impacts we are having in the vast Laguna watershed where two-thirds of Sonoma County lives. In addition to the excellent restoration and sediment reduction work, the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th graders and Camp Tule attendees who experience our environmental education programs are exposed to life-changing experiences in nature. If you have attended our community education programs at the Laguna Environmental Center or in the field, or are one of our 600 volunteers, you have experienced other important ways we are sharing the many qualities of the Laguna with the public.

Your ongoing generosity truly makes all of these accomplishments and community involvement opportunities possible. Thank you for sharing our vision and stepping forward to make it possible for us to pursue our dreams of a swimmable and fishable Laguna.

Improving water quality and enhancing wildlife habitat through

RESTORATION & CONSERVATION SCIENCE

The Laguna de Santa Rosa watershed faces multiple ecological challenges, from threats to endangered species, to impaired water quality, and climate change. We partner with both public and private entities to find innovative solutions to these problems and to restore a diverse, ecologically sustainable Laguna.

Irwin Creek Restoration

This year marked the completion of our restoration project at Irwin Creek in Santa Rosa. When we began in 2014, the creek channel was choked with 15'-tall invasive Himalayan blackberry among a narrow strip of trees.

The blackberry has been replaced by native sedge beds and other riparian plants and trees that resist reinvasion of non-native species. The riparian corridor is now 400'wide and includes vernal pools, native trees, and large patches of native milkweed to attract Monarch butterflies.

Gravenstein Creek Restoration

Our successful restoration project on Gravenstein Creek is now in its third year. Alongside Sonoma Resource Conservation District and Point Blue Conservation Science, we are working to extend this project upstream to restore an additional 2.5 acres.

Expanding our Impact with

NEW PROJECTS AND PARTNERSHIPS

In 2018-2019 we worked on more than 30 diverse projects that included trash clean-up throughout the watershed, growing endangered plant species, and implementing conservation grazing methods to help control invasive plants, support vernal pool habitat, and mitigate fire risks.

Conservation of Sebastopol Meadowfoam

Our conservation grazing program at Balletto Field in Santa Rosa has expanded to include the conservation of endangered Sebastopol meadowfoam *(Limnanthes vinculans)*. From 400 seeds collected in spring, plants grown in our nursery produced an incredible 130,800 seeds. The meadowfoam will be replanted in Balletto Field, adjacent to the Laguna where it once thrived. This successful project will help the recovery of this declining species.

Restoration of Cunningham Marsh

In collaboration with the California Native Plant Society and the United States Fish and Wildlife Service, we have launched a restoration project to ensure the continuance of the endangered Pitkin marsh lily (*Lilium pardalinum ssp. pitkinense*), in its last known location at Cunningham Marsh in Sebastopol. Over the next three years we will remove invasive Himalayan blackberry and velvet grass, and restore important habitat for native azalea, black oak woodland, and ensure the protection of the beautiful native lily.

Restoration of Roseland Creek

We began a new restoration project along Roseland Creek in Santa Rosa that will replace invasive shrubs and trees with native trees and sedges. This is the beginning of a larger collaboration with the local community and the City of Santa Rosa. The protection and restoration of remnant patches of native forest will also enhance Roseland Creek Elementary School's ability to provide a beautiful spot for students to explore and be inspired.

Fire Recovery at Hood Mountain

Over 20 different species of seed have been collected from burned and unburned areas at Hood Mountain Regional Park. This effort will restore bulldozer lines where top soils were removed and plant life has not restablished on its own following the 2017 wildfires. Our new nursery will soon be occupied with seedlings to be planted next fall.



PROTECTING the Laguna's flood capacity

Last winter's floods showed us how important the Laguna floodplain is to the Russian River watershed. Unfortunately, the floodplain is rapidly filling in with sediment that washes out of the hills and is deposited in the Laguna. As this happens, the holding capacity of the flood basin is reduced and flooding becomes more severe in communities along the Laguna de Santa Rosa and the Russian River, from Sebastopol to Guerneville.

In an exciting partnership with the Federated Indians of Graton Rancheria, we have begun to identify the origins of sediment in the upper watershed. Beginning in Copeland Creek in Rohnert Park, an important tributary to the Laguna, this project addresses the erosion issues at their source. In addition, we are studying how wildlife use this important corridor. In ongoing collaborations with the City of Rohnert Park, Sonoma State University, and local schools, we are working to restore this valuable creek while addressing impacts of erosion along the Laguna.

Sharing the wonders of the Laguna at our COMMUNITY EDUCATION PROGRAMS

This dynamic, year-round collection of programs drew devoted Laguna advocates and newcomers alike, inspiring deeper connections to our home environment for all participants. More than 1,475 people joined us for one of the 51 programs we offered this last year. From sharing the awe-inspiring moments of watching bird nestlings, to weaving plant materials into baskets, these experiences built community and provided a place to celebrate and grow appreciation for the natural world.

Highlights included talks and workshops by regional experts on traditional environmental knowledge and climate change, wetland birds of the Laguna, mountain lions, and the state of the ocean off Northern California. Additional programs included a walk focused on wild food and medicine, an expressive nature photography class, colored pencil drawing and watercolor workshops for beginning and skilled painters.
